- Ensure every encounter includes provider signature and credentials.

2■ Modifier Accuracy & CPT Consistency

- ✓ Review modifier use (25, 59, 95) for payer compliance.
- ✓ Audit high-level E/M codes for accuracy.
- ✓ Eliminate duplicate or overlapping claims before submission.

3■ POS & Telehealth Compliance

- ✓ Use correct POS codes for telehealth (02, 10).
- ✓ Maintain documented patient consent for all virtual visits.
- ✓ Validate payer rules for remote and hybrid appointments.

4 Denial Pattern Review

- ✓ Review top denial categories monthly (eligibility, coding, prior auth).
- ✓ Track recurring denials and adjust workflow.
- ✓ Implement denial prevention training for staff.

5 Internal Audit Schedule

- ✓ Conduct quarterly internal audits or sample 10 random claims monthly.
- ✓ Maintain a written audit log with findings and corrective action.
- ✓ Schedule annual external compliance review for objectivity.

6■ Staff Training & Compliance Logs

- ✔ Provide annual CPT, ICD, and payer policy training.
- ✓ Document all staff certifications and HIPAA acknowledgments.
- ✓ Keep OIG compliance attestations updated and accessible.
